The keynote speech and special speech to be presented on the first day of JA2016 (Wednesday October 12) will touch on challenges and new directions in light of the launch of the Acquisition, Technology & Logistics Agency (ATLA) a year ago by ATLA, including a presentation by Mitsubishi Heavy Industries on the development of the MRJ—the first Japanese-manufactured passenger airliner in half a century. Six such sessions will be presented.

In addition, through its industry professional seminars conducted from Thursday October 13 to Friday October 14, JA2016 has developed a program aimed at experts involved in the aerospace and defense industries. These seminars will touch on technology and expectations of Japan in civil aviation, industrial application of satellites and perspectives on the utilization of space, initiatives and challenges for the aircraft industry and comprehensive aerospace development, as well as defense seminars and much more.

An extensive program of joint seminars will also be available, including an aerospace industry cluster forum, the "Sky Day, Space Day" memorial lecture, and symposiums presented by JAXA and University of Tokyo's Institute of Industrial Science, among others.
